Amy Baldock with 20 points for Devonport Under 18, Samantha Clements 20 points for Devonport Under 16 and Taylah Bourke 25 points for Devonport Under 14 led the way for their respective teams. Somerset also had a good day at home against Latrobe with wins in all divisions. Emily Smith had 30 points for the Somerset Under 18 girls and Kyle Clark topped the Under 14 boys scorers with 26 points. Burnie played host to Wynyard with the game of the day being played in the Under 18 girls division. Burnie got over the line by a point, 27-26. In the Under 18 boys game Brian Van Wyk and Aaron Butler displayed strong form again scoring 24 points each in their teams win. Wynyard Under 14 girls upset their higher ranked opponent defeating the Burnie girls 65-50 with Danielle Radford from Wynyard scoring a game high 23 points.
