

NWBU Junior Roster 2010 – Round 13 – Sunday July 25 – By Jonathan Bourke

The penultimate round of the NWBU Junior roster was held over the weekend and finalists have been decided in all divisions except one. Teams have the final round next weekend followed by a weeks break and then finals. Burnie hosted Latrobe getting wins in five of six divisions. Latrobe's Under 18 girls held off a determined Burnie side to gain victory by 2 points, 28-26 in the only clash that didn't go Burnie's way. Burnie Under 16 girls remain undefeated after a strong win led by Shannae Martin with 22 points and would be decided favourites heading into finals. Keigan Lucas with 25 points helped her Burnie Under 14 girls team to a solid win also. Burnie's Under 16 boys had a big win over the Latrobe boys in a well balanced team effort that saw them win by 56 points. Ulverstone made the journey to Devonport and their Under 18 girls side put in another solid performance, led again by Ella Fox, 25 points and Hannah Gale, 21 points. Devonport managed a couple of good wins in the Under 16 and Under 14 girls games. The boys games saw Ulverstone take a comfortable win in the Under 18's whilst Devonport were too big and strong in the Under 16 boys. Jakeb Morrison with 23 points for Devonport Under 16 boys. The Under 14 boys game was the tightest affair with Ulverstone toughing out a 52-46 victory. Wynyard and Somerset also split the victories 3 each. The Under 18 boys game needed overtime to split the two teams with Wynyard running away with victory. Wynyard's Kubicki brothers combined for 52 points in the Under 16 boys game getting a big win over Somerset. The Wynyard Under 16 girls also got away with a narrow victory defeating the Somerset girls by only 3 points. Somerset's two Under 14 teams, both ladder leaders, got strong wins over their opposition. Sami Phillips had 21 points for Somerset Under 14 girls and Kyle Clark with 26 points led the Somerset Under 14 boys. Smithton visited Penguin in the last group of games, where Penguin took the spoils in all the girls games and Smithton in all the boys games. Both Smithton boys teams getting upwards of 70 points each. The Penguin Under 16 girls were the best performed of the Penguin sides, defeating Smithton 70-14.
