UNDER 14 BOYS AND GIRLS TOURNAMENT RULES

- NW Rep sides are permitted to enter, however are not eligible for the finals
- NW Rep players are to give priority to home association first
- Players must compete in 50% of preliminary games to be eligible for the finals
- Players must be under 14 as at 31st December 2010 to be eligible
- Drawn games will remain as a draw for preliminary games - no overtime.
- Size 6 Ball
- 4 x 10 minute quarters
- 1 minute break between quarters
- 2 minutes at half time
- Clock will be set to 11 mins at $\frac{1}{4}$ & $\frac{3}{4}$ time and 12 mins at half time and let run
- Back court rule applies (including 8 second rule)
- Clock does not stop (exception being last 2 mins if points diff is 5 or less - see below)
- Warm-up time depends on time availability
- 1 Time out per quarter
- No 24 second clock
- Clock stops in last 2 minutes (FIBA rules) only if points difference is 5 or less
- No zone defence
- Teams are required to supply referee
- Teams are expected to supply bench person
- Penguin Basketball Association reserves the right to change or alter rules of this tournament to maximize player participation and enjoyment.
